

CP24 - FILTERED WATER POLICY

That private people who require filtered water be offered the 3 year payment period for headworks charges.

That the Council adopt the following developer contribution as policy for the provision of filtered water and unfiltered water to Rural Residential subdivision in the 1(c) zone as set out in the Management Plan.

Headworks Contributions - filtered Water

The headworks contribution is based on the cost to service a particular area on a per hectare basis (to include fire fighting provisions).

Reticulation - Filtered Water

All works associated with reticulation shall be at full cost to the developer.

Water Right Transfer

Water right transfer is based on the annual allocation of water consumed appropriate for Rural Residential subdivision/development (currently 1.75 megalitres per allotment).

In the event of a greater need then the developer will transfer water right based on user pay for the increase.
