

## CP56 - ROADS

That Council:-

- (a) Annually review the road budget to ensure that sufficient funds are made available for the proper maintenance and development of roads under the care of Council,
- (b) reviews annually the road maintenance and construction program,
- (c) Council develops a five year rolling program of works for road maintenance and construction.

### Pipes under Roads

All pipework placed under roadways shall be sleeved in a polythene material.

Such installation shall be the subject of an application to the Council and road opening permit obtained and complied with.

### Tarawi Bore

That in addition to rights being granted to enter the Tarawi Bore site for obtaining water, Council and any of its appointed agents be granted right to enter the site since the Trusteeship will be under Council control.

### Road Side Plantings

That no new plantings be allowed on road reserves and that Council require property owners to remove existing plantings from road reserves where such plantings either create a safety hazard or affect Council's road works or maintenance.

### Road Closures

Authority for short term (less than 24 hours) temporary road closures be delegated to the General Manager provided there are no objections and the Traffic Facilities Committee concurs.

### Sealed Roads in the Rural Area

That Council adopt a minimum seal width of 5.6m for low trafficked rural roads, 6.1m for roads having traffic counts above 300 vehicles per day and 6.5m wide seals for roads carrying B-doubles and/or counts higher than 800 vehicles per day.
