Works are underway on the upgrade of the Buronga EDS and scheduled for completion late 2020.

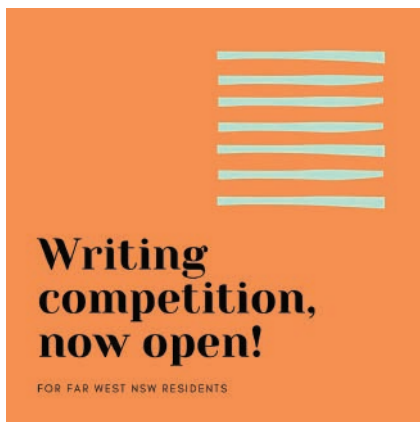
COMMUNITY GROUPS SAFETY PLANS
