NOTICE OF PUBLIC EXHIBITION & COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Planning Proposal to amend the Wentworth Local Environmental Plan 2011

In accordance with Section 3.34(2)(c) and Schedule 1 Clause 4 of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979, Wentworth Shire Council gives public notice of the exhibition of a planning proposal to amend the Wentworth LEP 2011. The amendment seeks to rezone 26 Gol Gol North Road, Gol Gol from RU1 Primary Production zone to RU5 Village zone and removal of minimum lot size.

Pursuant to the conditions of the Gateway Determination issued by Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, the following supporting documents will be concurrently exhibited:
