### USE OF THE MURRAY RIVER

Border community residents can use the Murray River for recreational purposes as part of the Cross Border Community area.

NSW residents, outside of the Cross Border Community area can use the Murray River and should avoid disembarking on the southern bank. Should residents need to disembark, they must stay below the top of the river bank and should not mingle with Victorian residents. Victorian residents are not permitted to board a boat with NSW residents who reside outside of the border community region.

### NSW/VIC BORDER UPDATE

People who live in a border community don't need a permit to travel into Victoria but must carry a valid form of photographic ID with a current address when travelling. If you have travelled beyond New South Wales' border communities in the past 14 days, you will need a travel permit, exception or exemption to cross the border and enter Victoria. Border residents from both New South Wales and Victoria are able to travel as they would for their normal day-to-day activities like work, shopping and eating out within the border bubble.

Following continued low community transmission and exposure risk, from 6:00pm last night the last red zone in New South Wales has transitioned to an orange zone, allowing anyone from New South Wales with a permit to enter Victoria. The Local Government Area (LGA) of Cumberland has transitioned to an orange zone and all remaining orange zones have transitioned to green.

This means the Greater Sydney LGAs of Blacktown City, Burwood, Canada Bay City, Canterbury-Bankstown, Fairfield City, Inner West, Parramatta City and Strathfield Municipality and Liverpool have moved from orange to green. Wollongong and the Blue Mountains have also moved to green, leaving Cumberland as the only remaining orange zone.

Travel from an orange zone requires people to self-isolate on arrival in Victoria, get tested within 72 hours of arrival and remain in quarantine until they receive a negative result. Test results are usually sent within 24 hours. Travel from a green zone requires people to watch and get tested if they have any symptoms at all.

### NSW/SOUTH AUSTRALIA BORDER UPDATE

A Cross Border Community Travel Zone exists allowing for residents in the 100 km corridor of the NSW/SA border e.g. Wentworth (please note: sections of the Shire are not included in the corridor) to enter South Australia and travel anywhere in the state. Cross Border Community members arriving in South Australia are required to provide proof of a COVID-19 test, or test result, within the last 7 days, or submit to testing within 24 hours from arrival, and on day 5 and 12.
