Changes to Waste Facilities in Wentworth Shire: Trial of Amended Operating Hours

Wentworth Shire Council wishes to inform the community of changes to waste facility operations across the Shire.

In response to concerns regarding the increased risk of fires and staff fatigue during extreme heat, facilities will open and close two hours earlier on days when temperatures exceed 40°C.

The trial period for the amended operating hours will be in effect from Saturday 1 February until Sunday 16 March 2025.
