WENTWORTH HOUSEBOAT EFFLUENT DISPOSAL SYSTEM (EDS) CLOSED

The gangway structure of the Wentworth EDS in Adams Street suffered from fire damage on Wednesday 22 January 2025. The small fire was contained by the local Rural Fire Brigade, with the gangway, pipework and services damaged.

Wentworth Shire Council has closed the system from future use until the damaged pipework and services can be repaired.

Houseboat owners are directed to use the Dareton Effluent Disposal System until further advised from Council.

WENTWORTH RIVERFRONT MOORING TEMPORARY CLOSURE - CONCRETE WORKS

Wentworth Shire Council wishes to advise the community that the Wentworth riverfront mooring area is currently closed to the public (as of Monday 17 February) to facilitate works to raise the level of the existing mooring to better suit the requirements of users.

Alternative mooring sites are located adjacent the Wentworth Wharf. Works are expected to take approximately eight weeks.
