FOSO Opening Update

The highly anticipated opening of the Fibre Optic Symphonic Orchestra (FOSO) has been rescheduled to Friday 24 April 2026. This follows a record-breaking 250mm deluge across the Wentworth and Mildura regions, which caused significant ground damage and boggy conditions at the site near the Perry Sandhills and Thegoa Lagoon.

While the delay is disappointing, prioritising a world-class guest experience remains Council's focus. Although the FOSO opening is delayed, the complementary Trail of Lights experience in Mildura remains open over the Easter period.
